## Rain Garden Kit

*Full to partial sun*  
*Plants tolerate seasonal wet/dry soil*

swamp milkweed • sedge  
new-england aster • joe-pye weed  
common boneset • blue flag iris  
soft-stemmed rush  
foxglove beard-tongue  
common mountain mint  
riddell's goldenrod  
common spiderwort  
missouri ironweed

## Woodland Wildflower Kit

*Shade loving plants*

thimbleweed • nodding onion  
heart-leaved aster • sedge  
white snakeroot  
early meadow-rue  
woodland sunflower • alum root  
bottlebrush grass • jumpseed  
foxglove beard-tongue  
blue-stemmed goldenrod  
broad-leaved goldenrod

Kits contain a mix of 10–12 different native grasses and wildflowers. Kits are available as either 32 plugs or 8 quart-size perennials. Kits must be pre-ordered and pre-paid. Some kits may not contain all the species listed due to availability; an appropriate substitution will be made. All plants are grown by the Native Plant Nursery ([www.nativeplant.com](http://www.nativeplant.com)) in Ann Arbor and are Michigan native species propagated from Michigan sources. The Native Plant Nursery is a member of the Michigan Native Plant Producers Association ([www.mnppa.org](http://www.mnppa.org)). Plugs are in cardboard containers 1½ x 1½ x 6 inches deep and the kits of 32 plugs will be neatly packaged in a paper bag.
